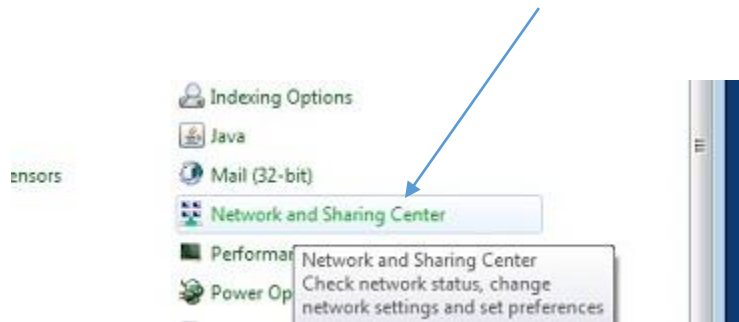


Updating Security Certificate for USFWireless-Auth

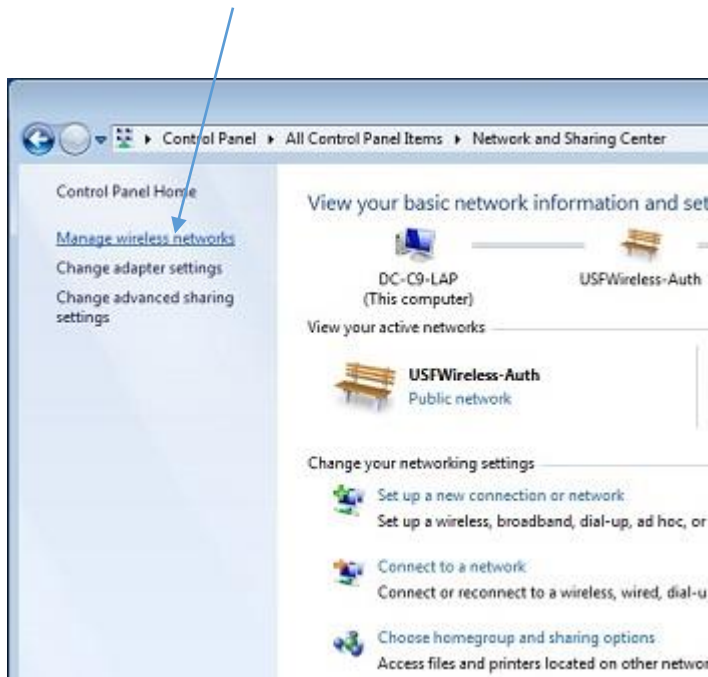
You may notice that your windows 7 device does not auto connect to USFWireless-Auth, as it did previously. Please follow the instructions below to update your connection.

Click the Windows button in the lower left corner, select Control Panel.

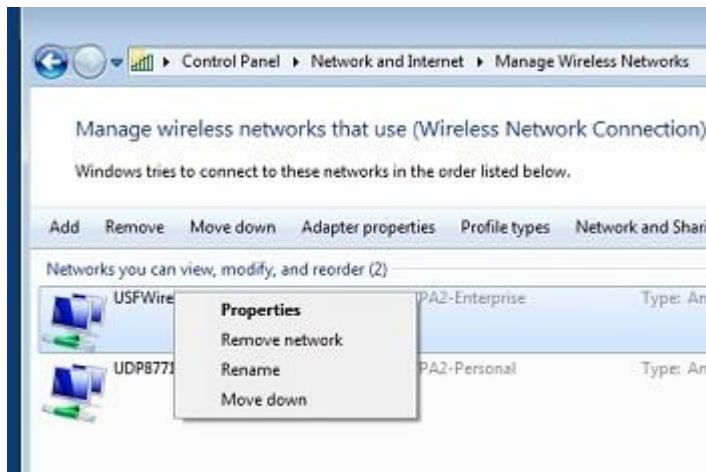
In the window that opens, click network and sharing center.



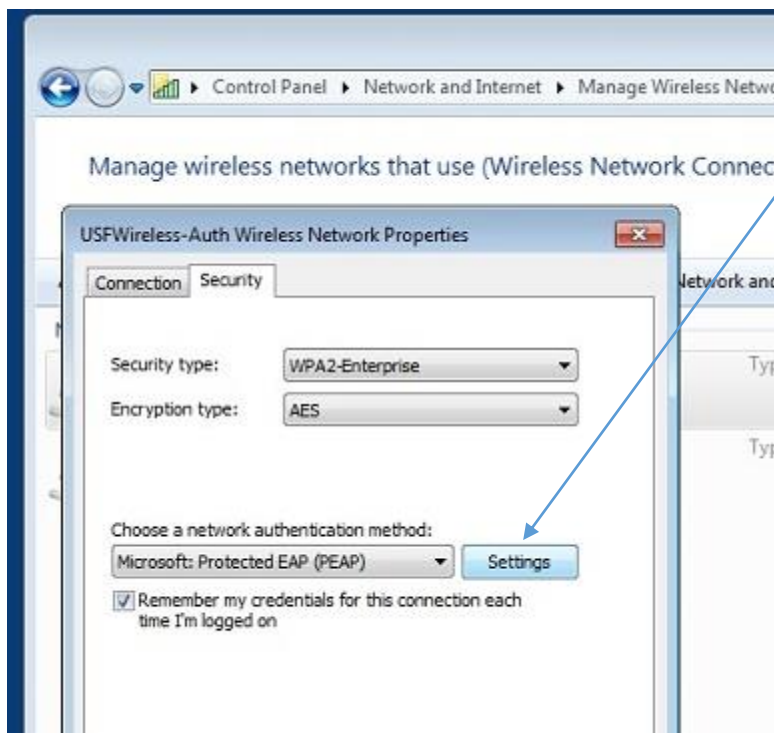
Click Manage Wireless Networks on the left of the window.



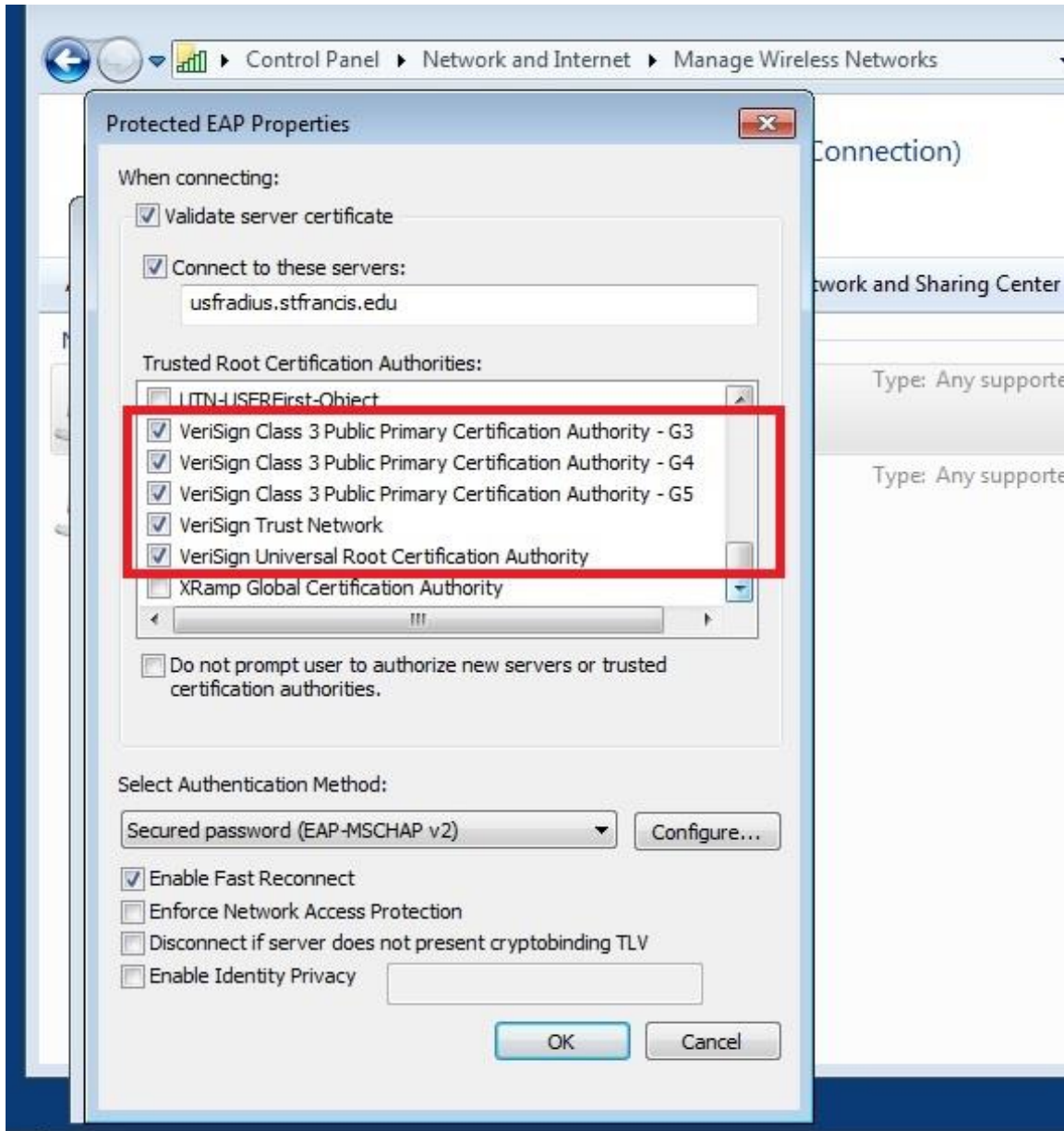
Find USFWireless-Auth from your list of saved networks. Right Click and select properties.



In the properties window, click the Security tab. From the security tab, click Settings button.



Scroll down in the Trusted Root Certificate Authorities, place a check box in all items that start with Verisign. Click OK to close any open windows.



Locate and click on the wireless icon in the lower right corner of your desktop screen, click on USFWireless-Auth and then Connect.



You will be prompted for your USF username and password. Enter your credentials and click OK.



If successful, your device should connect and continue do so, automatically, in the future.
