

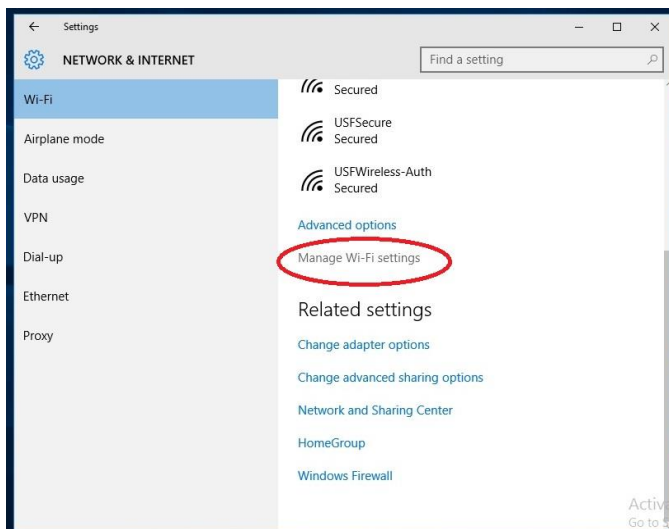
## Windows 10 Password Update for USFWireless-Auth

If you have recently changed your password and are unable to connect to USFWireless-Auth, your password will need to be updated within the wireless profile. The easiest way to accomplish this is to forget the USFWireless-Auth network and connect again to create a new profile with your new password. Please follow the directions below to accomplish this.

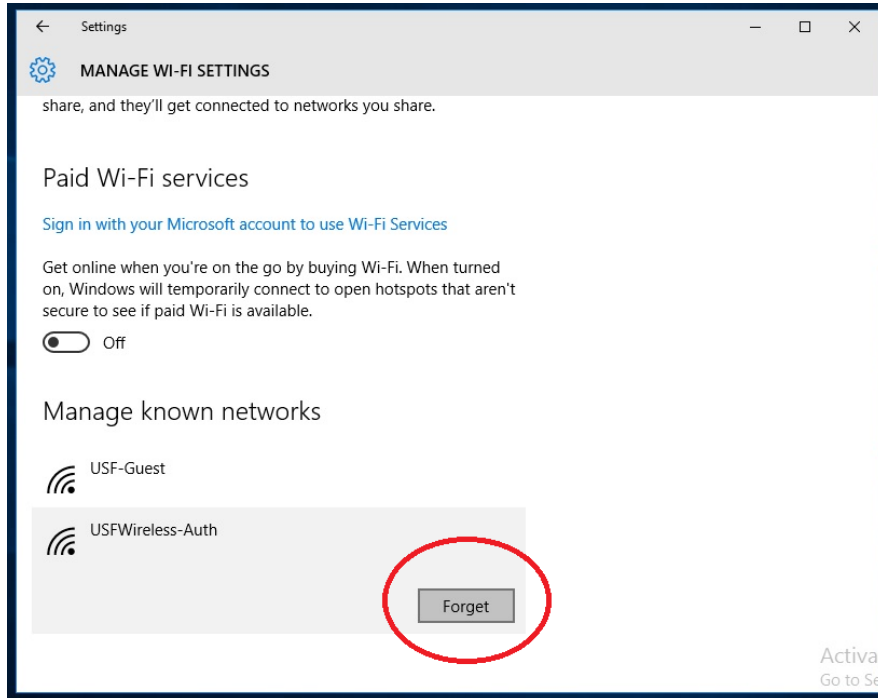
From your desktop, click the wireless network icon in the lower right system tray. Then select **Network Settings**.



Once the network settings window opens, scroll down and click on **Manage wifi settings**.



Once again, scroll down and look for **manage known networks**. In the list of known networks, look for USFWireless-Auth. Click on USFWireless-Auth to select it. A forget button should appear, click forget for the USFWireless-Auth network.



You may now go back and re-connect to the network and should be prompted for your new username and password. If you are unsure of how to connect please visit:
